4. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The event follows the regulations imposed by Finnish National Sporting Authority (AKK-Motorsport ry, AKK) including the Finnish Sporting Code (FSC), Finnish Rally Regulations (FRR) and the Supplementary Regulations of Snow Rally Rings 2022. The Supplementary Regulations in Finnish have been approved by AKK with competition license number 27/R/2022.

This translations of the Supplementary Regulations for Snow Rally Rings 2022 are informational only and in case of disputes the official Supplementary Regulations in Finnish is the authoritative version.

The complete rally route total length is 101,01 km, including 5 special stages with combined length of 71,75 km and there is one leg in the Rally, which will be run on Saturday 26.3.2022. There are two sections in the rally.

Section 1 total length is 4,12 km, including 1 special stage.

Section 2 total length is 96,89km km, including 4 special stages with total combined length of 67,63 km.

The official time of the event is the Official Finnish Time, which can be found at <https://time.is>. The Virtual Official Noticeboard contains the link to the official time.

If any competitors or persons working for them are met on the non-arterial roads in the region of Rovaniemi, before their official start time, their participation to the event is prohibited. (Exception: Chapter 12. Reconnaissance).

The event follows the regulations by Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (FINCIS), which can be found at suek.fi, as well all doping related Finnish legislation.

General COVID-19 instructions for competitors:

- Participate only in good health:
 - If you notice sudden symptoms of a respiratory infection, such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath, always call the local health service first. Do not go to the health center or emergency room to spread the infection and avoid all social contacts. You will receive instructions on how to apply for treatment on the phone.
 - Lapland Central Hospital emergency service, tel. +358 16 322 4800 (24 h)
- We recommend keeping a safety distance of 2 m or a mask and take care of good hand hygiene and use hand sanitizer
- We recommend you to always wear the mask at the Competition Center and elsewhere if you are unable to maintain the 2m safety distance to other persons in the area.
- Always wear a mask in any interviews.
- Effort has been made to eliminate encounters between competition officials and competitors. Only one person should visit the Rally Office when retrieving competition and other material.
- Competitors must maintain the 2m safety distance or wear a mask in their encounters during the competition if the safety distance cannot be maintained.

6. ENTRY PROCEDURE

Anyone wishing to enter the Snow Rally Rings 2022 must register through the KIT1 system or request secondary registration instructions from the secretary of the rally.

The first 80 competitors registered in accordance with the rules will be accepted for the competition.

Use of competitor information by the organizer

By entering the competition, the competitor accepts the processing of personal data provided by the organizer and the publication and inclusion of specified personal information (name, club, etc.) in the entry list, results list, etc. in all organizer's communications and registers. The organizer also reserves the right to disclose relevant published information to use by third parties.

7. ENTRY FEES

The participation fees are as follows: 250 €

Entry and the entry fee need to have reached the organizer by 21.03.2022 at 11.59.

Registration for the competition may be closed before this deadline if the maximum number of competitors according to section 6 is reached.

8. SERVICE

COVID-19 instructions:

- Always wear the mask at the competition center and outside your service area.
- Competitors and service personnel must maintain a safety distance of 2 m and use a mask when encountering other competitors or their service personnel if the safety distance cannot be maintained.

The route has a centralized Service Park with three services. There is a service whenever the rally route passes through the service area. There are no time controls in the service park and the competitor can use the time he / she decides for service, taking into account the time required to move to the time control before the special stage.

Service vehicles must have a competitor-specific fire extinguisher and an oil absorption mat ready for use, and a liquid-impermeable cover at least equal to the floor area of the rally car. Service vehicles must use a liquid-tight protective cover at least the size of the engine compartment. The absence of any of these will result in immediate exclusion from the competition by decision of the Clerk of the Course.

9. TYRES

It is allowed to use Tyres according to Finnish Sporting Code 2022 Appendix J Art. 6.1.2 Studded tires or previous year's Finnish Rally Regulations Appendix J Art. 6.1.2 Studded tires ("old rule" with 16-inch tires).

In Historic cars, the rim size according to the car classification and / or Appendix K. Tyres do not have to be homologated and can comply with the so-called "old rule".

10. REFUELING

COVID-19 instructions

- Competitors and service crew must maintain a safety distance of 2m or if the safety distance cannot be maintained, wear a mask in encounters with other competitors and their service crew

Refueling is only permitted in the refueling area connected to the service park whenever the route is in the service park.

Rules for refueling activities:

- all activities not related to refueling are prohibited
- the engine must be switched off during refueling
- a pair of competitors should be outside the car during refueling, but if they remain inside the car, the seat belts should be open
- refueling service personnel (max. 2 people)
- during refueling, the absorption mat must be under the refueling point

11. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Competitors must provide all Administrative Documents to the Organizer using the provided digital tools by 23.3.2022 at 23.59. Documents not available at the time must be provided as soon as possible.

Administrative Checks will be made based on the digitally provided documents and information before opening of the Rally Office.

The competitors must however keep all required documents available in the vehicle during the whole competition.

12. RECONNAISSANCE

COVID-19 instructions:

- Arrive only in good health
- maintain a good hand hygiene
- use hand sanitizer
- wear a mask
- maintain the 2m safety distance
- only one competitor will pick up the material

From 25.03.2022 at 1800, competitors can pick up reconnaissance material from the competition office. When acknowledging receipt of the material, the competitor must provide the organizer with information about his reconnaissance car and his telephone number.

The two (2) reconnaissance identification numbers must be attached to the car to the windshield to the top center and to the right rear window and must be visible whole duration of the reconnaissance.

A maximum speed limit of 80 km/h is in place during the whole reconnaissance on all special stages, unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs placed by the organiser. The competitor must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages. Driving against the direction of the rally is prohibited, unless directed so by the organiser, their representative or the police. The organizer will control speeds used as well as the manner of driving during reconnaissance. Also the police will make checks along the route and will penalise for traffic infringements according to Finnish Traffic Law.

Officials with the organizers' logo must stop complying with the threat of denial of the right of departure.

Reconnaissance cars

Only road homologated tyres are allowed during reconnaissance.

In the reconnaissance car, there must be warm overalls for drivers, a snow shovel, a first aid kit, a tow rope and a reflecting triangle to be used for warning following cars in case of road blockage.

Reconnaissance starts on 26.03.2022 at 06.00 and will end on 26.03.2022 at 11.00. Reconnaissance is allowed within the time limit

13. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Competition number sticker with organiser ads: 67x20 cm on doors.

Advertisement on the competition number: Snow Rally Rings

Competition number stickers on doors must be placed so that the competition number is towards the front of the car.

The number sticker also includes the organizer's phone number for emergencies.

14. PRE-EVENT SCRUTINEERING

Pre-event Scrutineering at Service Park on 26.3.2022 at 0700–1100. the Scrutineering is carried out by an inspection team going around the Service Park.

- The drivers do not need to personally attend the pre-event scrutineering
- Competitors' and car's documents will be checked from the digitally provided materials
- The competitor submits scanned documents digitally according to instructions at the event website
- The competitor must have the required documents available at the scrutineering
- The competitors and their representatives must act at the scrutineering according to organizer's instructions

- Competitors are not given a scrutineering card. Instead, the documentation of the scrutineering remains with the inspection staff, but the vehicles are marked as an approved inspection.

The organizer will go around the Service Park to perform a safety check, so please leave the race car open and the documents and driving equipment available to the inspection staff unless a competitor's representative is present.

15. SHAKEDOWN STAGE

The Shakedown Stage will be available near the Service Park on 26.03.2022 at 07.00–11.00. Use of the Shakedown is included in the Entry Free. Stage map and Road Book pages are included in the event Road Book and are also available on the Virtual Official Noticeboard. Timing will not be provided for the Shakedown.

16. COMPETITION MATERIALS

Classes 1–6 and 9 -11

Each crew will receive one road book describing the rally route in detail and two route maps starting on 25.03.2022 at 1600 and continues during the opening hours of the Rally office on 26.03.2022 until 1030. the timing transponders will be distributed at the waiting area preceding the start of SS1.

Classes 7–8

Each crew will receive one road book describing the rally route in detail and two route maps starting on 26.03.2022 at 1000 – 1030 at Rally office. The timing transponders will be distributed at the waiting area preceding the start of SS1.

17. COURSE OF THE RALLY

The driver or co-driver must have a GSM phone powered on in the rally car in case of an accident. Phone number must be provided to the Rally Office before start using the digital form at the event website.

During the rally, the competitor must have the organizer's timing transponder in his car. The timing transponders will be distributed at the waiting area preceding the start of SS1. The transponder will be collected from competitors at the finish.

Competitors' start times will be published on the Virtual Official Noticeboard on 26.3.2022 at 1100.

The first competitor starts the rally from SS1 Time Control on 26.3.2022 at 12.00.

The competitor must arrive at the SS 1 Time Control at his / hers start time to the race.

The Clerk of the Course will set a starting interval between competitors due to safety reasons. The interval may change during the event.

The Clerk of the Course has the right to move the competitor to another starting position for safety reasons.

As a method of implementation, the Clerk of the Course's decision of the time after which competitor will go to the Time Control, the information will be provided to the rally car by the Competitors' Relations Officer. The implementation method is mainly to move a slower competitor backwards.

COVID-19 related exceptions to using the timecard (Exception to Finnish Rally Regulations Art. 14.5 Timecard)

- In order maintain a safety distance between competitors and officials and to avoid paper transfers, timecards have been placed in the road book. Timecards are intended for the competitors' own use and may and should be marked by the competitors.
- At Time Controls, competitors do need to not open windows or hatches for officials, but show a willingness to record handing out a timecard to an official by placing the card against the window or by making a handout gesture. The clerks nod as a sign of their observation and record the time on a large timecard corresponding to the competitor's timecard and present the time to the competitors. Competitors will mark the corresponding time (s) on their timecard and acknowledge receipt by raising their thumb
- At the start of SS the start time for SS will be shown to the competitor from the official car and the competitor will mark it on his own time card.
 - The officials will show if an start interval other than 1 minute is planned. If a competitor encounters a need for a change request against a timecard entry, a request must be made as follows:
 - In this case, the officials only show the start time to the competitor in the minute before the start, as if she would normally only be given a time card at the last minute.
- At the Stop Control, the time will be given from the stop car, which the competitor records on his/hers time card himself.
- If a competitor encounters a need for a change request against a timecard entry, a request must be made as follows:

Section 2

Start list for Section 2 will be published on Virtual Official Notice Board according to the Rally Programme on 26.3.2022 at 1330. Starting order for Section 2 will be according to SS1 results by classes.

The Rally will be run according to the route markings, schedule and international time card described in the road book. The due time given in the time card is added to the actual start time of the special stage, which gives the arrival time to the following time control. The due time includes the special stage time and the following liaison section. If the competitor arrives at any other time control than the start of a special stage, the arrival time will also be the time of departure from the time control, unless a different time is given by the time control officials. Instructions on the use of the timecard can be found at the Rally Guide and the Road Book.

Route given in the Road Book must be followed on the liaison sections, under penalty of exclusion by the Clerk of the Course.

Each car must carry one snow shovel, first aid kit, warm clothes and two reflective triangles. The co-driver can use non-FIA approved shoes.

18. RESULTS

Provisional final classification will be published according to the event programme on the Virtual Official Noticeboard by Classes on 26.3.2022 starting at 1930, followed by the official classification both on the VONB and the event website.

19. PRIZES AND PRIZE-GIVING

Number of awarded drives will be published on the Virtual Official Noticeboard.

Both drivers will be awarded at the Ceremonial Finnish on Competition Center at 20.00 by the official classification.
